



Sam and His Dad is a joyful and funny celebration of ordinary family life, the little details that excite a child's imagination and the quirky ways they interpret the adult world. It's a book any child can see themselves in and relate to.

Illustrator of <u>The Enemy</u> and <u>I Love Kissing You</u>, Serge Bloch is one of the outstanding illustrators of his generation. His work as an editorial illustrator appears regularly in *The Washington Post*, *Wall Street Journal*, Chicago Tribune, The New York Times and Los Angeles Times, as well as Time and New York Magazine.

He recently received a Gold Medal from the American Society of Illustrators. He lives in Paris with his wife and son.

A previous collaboration with <u>Davide Cali</u>, *I Can't Wait*, won France's prestigious Baobab Prize for the most innovative book of 2005 and was Honour Book in the American Library Association's <u>Batchelder Award</u>.
